Speech is one of the most beneficial co-curricular activities a student can participate in during high school and we're thrilled to have you as part of our family. We've had tremendous success over the past few years, with multiple State Champions, multiple State Finalists, and multiple top ten finishes for the team. That may explain why more than 100 students auditioned for our team this past week.

Our success has been due to the talent, dedication, hard work, and determination of the team members, coaches, and parents. In order to continue on that path, each team member must commit him/herself to long hours of practice at home, practice over Zoom, and at competitions.

Obviously, a lot of things will change this year due to the pandemic. All practices and tournaments will be virtual until further notice. We are still working out those details. So the paragraph below is from last year!

A typical week consists of a team meeting after school on Monday, 2-3 practices with a Varsity team member or coach, a Category Rehearsal with others in the same event, and a Saturday tournament that runs from the early morning well into the evening. **Team members are required to attend all meetings and tournaments even if they are not competing.** This includes the novice-only tournament at the beginning of the year and the entire postseason in February.

The activity fee for the district applies to Speech Team as well and those dues are \$200 per child (**See details on the website**). This helps us pay for entry fees, judges, buses, and team supplies & materials. If there are any concerns about this, please let me know.

We ask that all parents who are new to the team (or weren't able to attend in the past) come to our **Speech Parents' Night on Thursday, November 5th from 7:00-8:00 p.m.** (Zoom link to come later!)
