APPLICATION PROCESS

1. **DUE DATE . . .** Complete this application form and submit it to Mehta no later than **Wednesday, March 7, 2012.**

2. **“WHY DO YOU DESERVE TO BE A CAPTAIN OF THE 2012-2013 SPEECH TEAM?” . . .** Your response to this question in a one-page, single-space, Times New Roman, 11 point font (or equivalent) is due with this application.

3. **TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS . . .** Ask for and submit with this application three (3) letters of recommendation from classroom teachers or adults (not related to you) who know you well! Likewise, the letters cannot be from a current Speech Coach. The letters should be in sealed envelopes with the teachers’ signatures across the seal of the envelope. Any letters not received in this fashion will be considered invalid and seriously threaten to disqualify any applicant.

4. **OTHER INFO...** Captainship does not automatically qualify you for the Regional Team. It doesn’t mean you necessarily get to choose your events. Please do not apply just so you have a line on your resume. Apply because you love this team and you want to help make it better. It’s a privilege, after all ☺

5. **A NOTE ON COMMITMENT . . .** The commitment it takes to be an NVHS Speech Team captain is, as you have witnessed, one not to be taken lightly. Captains help us choose the team, run the website, deal with issues that arise during the season, and make important decisions.

6. **FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION. . .** Despite your already very significant involvement in the team, captains will be expected to organize and assist with Summer Speech Camp, help run auditions, and help with anything else that comes up.
