David Scheidecker ("Shy") was a dedicated English teacher, theater director, and Speech coach. At the beginning of each Speech season, he would tell the students there are Four Pillars to life: Education, Faith, Health, and Family...all other involvement in co-curricular activities, including Speech, is secondary to these; nevertheless, Shy was a firm believer that participation in Speech is invaluable throughout a person's life.

David Scheidecker passed away suddenly at the young age of 56. In honor of his life and work, we are pleased to offer the David Scheidecker Memorial Scholarship. Eligibility Criteria

- The candidate must be a **Neuqua Valley High School graduating senior**.
- The candidate must have participated on a Speech Team for a minimum of **3 years**. If the candidate participated on a Speech Team other than Neuqua Valley, a letter from the former coach needs to be included with the application verifying participation.
- The candidate must have been a member of the Neuqua Valley Speech Team as a **senior for the entire season**.
- The candidate must have a **3.25** GPA or better.
- The candidate must submit **verification** of conditional acceptance to - and use this award for the full-time attendance at - a college (two or four years), university, trade school, or vocational school.
- There are no restrictions regarding which college, university, trade school or vocational school the candidate is attending. As well, there are no restrictions based on the candidate's intended major.
- The candidate must be a U.S. citizen.
- There are no restrictions regarding race, religion, gender, ethnicity, or physical disability.
- Eligibility is **not** based upon financial need.
- The candidate must complete and submit (3) copies of the scholarship application to Mr. Mehta by the deadline of **Monday, March 5, 2012**.
- The application must include a **typed essay** (as stated in the application form) no longer than two pages, double-spaced, Times New Roman, font size 12.

- *What have you gained from participation in Speech that you will carry with you through your life?*
- *How have the Four Pillars helped determine the type of person you currently are and hope to become?*
