CATEGORIES OFFERED

DDA Dramatic Duet Acting

Two performers in a dramatic scene of 8 minutes

DI Dramatic Interpretation

One performer interpreting several characters in a dramatic scene of 8 minutes

ES Extemporaneous Speaking

One performer responding to a current issue in 6 minutes with limited prep time

HDA Humorous Duet Acting

Two performers in a humorous scene of 8 minutes

HI Humorous Interpretation

One performer interpreting several characters in a humorous scene of 8 minutes

INF Informative Speaking

One performer presenting his or her original information with support for 8 minutes (less persuasive than OO).

IS Impromptu Speaking

One performer organizing, supporting, and presenting a response to a prompt in 8 total minutes

OO Original Oratory

One performer presenting his or her original ideas on a significant topic with support for 8 minutes

DEC Oratorical Declamation

One performer presenting the motivational, serious, or thoughtful words of another person in 8 minutes

OC Original Comedy

One performer presenting his or her original comedic script for 8 minutes

PO Poetry Reading

One performer reading a poem or program of poetry in 8 minutes

PR Prose Reading

One performer reading a fiction selection in 8 minutes

RS Radio Speaking

One performer organizing and presenting a 6-minute radio broadcast with limited prep time

SOS Special Occasion Speaking

One performer presenting original motivational, serious, and entertaining words of significance in 8 minutes
